Home Economics

- Task and practical to upload cookery.
- Work during the year - 50%, Engagement throughout entire year - 10%, Assignment to upload - 40%

Metalwork

- A common project is being assigned to all 2nd year metalwork groups. Broken into sections which will be completed week by week as in the plan submitted on google classroom for them.

Gaeilge

- 25% (Online tasks- eg week 1 slide on mo chlann, 2 slide mo scoil, 3 slide caitheamh aimsire, 4 passage - mo la scoile,)
- 50% exams during year, 25% google forms assessment

German

- There will be three short assessments during the final term. Listening skills + Vocabulary (40%) & Grammar (40%) will be assessed on Google Quiz. Students will also submit a written blog (20%)

French

- Online end of year assessment incorporating Grammar, vocab, comprehension and written

Technology

- 2nd years will be given a project worth a total of 100%. Each section will be broken down into 4 individual parts. The first section will be starting on Monday 27th April and will last for 4 weeks.

Visual Art

- Two realised pieces of work -one man-made or natural object and one work from imagination or secondary source. Full outline and submission timeline to be communicated with students via classroom.

Music

- submit one recording of a performance to be assessed [25%], students will select two compositions in which they completed throughout the year to be assessed along with their composition reflections [20%] Exam with short & long questions and listening



Graphics

- End of year Exam that will contribute to overall year mark .

Maths

- continuous assessment tasks on Google Classroom

Geography

- CBA type assessment on Google slides
- Ongoing weekly tasks on Google classroom

History

- Students are doing a CBA-style project

Woodwork

- Mini Brief - Shelf (including lathe work) - Secondary function, Analysis of brief, design ideas with pros/cons, final design, model.

Science

- Online assessment to be posted on Google Classroom

Business Studies

- Combination year average to date, online assessment and a project

CSPE

- 100% based on the students ongoing CBA project work and their contribution to class & the project during the year
