You are going to begin a new journey of learning, a new pathway – new subjects, many teachers and different ways of learning.

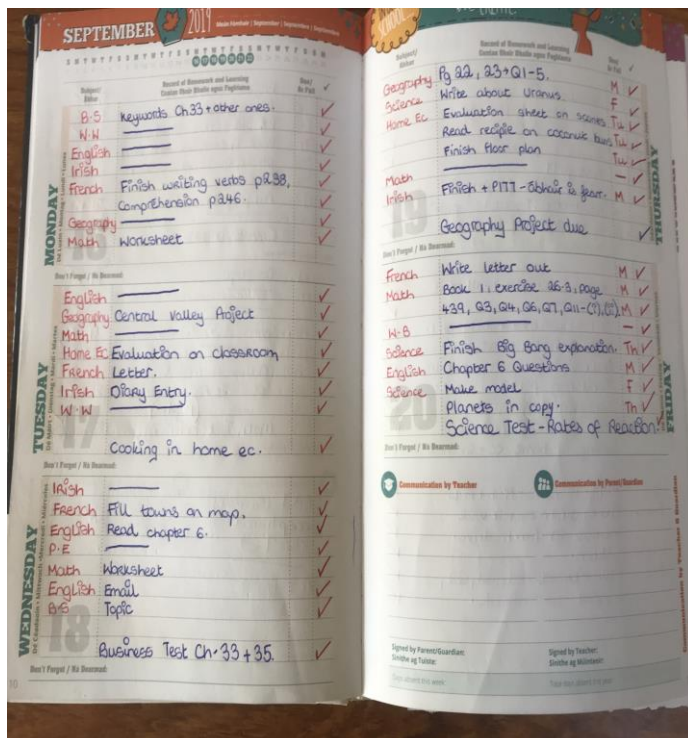
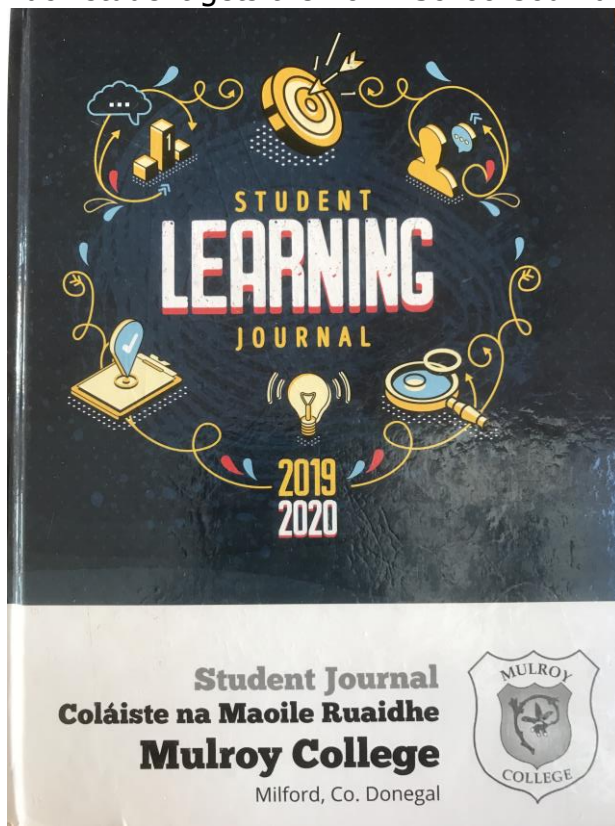
The pathway becomes easier when you put in the effort, look for help from others, try new things and learn from setbacks and disappointments.

Each student gets their own School Journal.



- The School Journal is used by you, your teachers and your parents
- At registration each morning you and your class teacher look at your journal, checking for notes from home, homework completed, plans for the week ahead
- At the start of each class your school journal is on the table in front of you – ready for use – mark down homework to do, materials to bring in, things to do!
- In the evenings as you complete your homework place a tick that it's done!
- Get your journal signed each night when your homework is complete by parent/guardian
- Absence notes are recorded by home in the Journal, show these to your class teacher in the morning.
- If you have to leave school early, show the note from home to your class teacher in the morning and then get it signed at the main office with Theresa/Donna
- Use your school journal to reflect and record your learning and progress, keep a record of marks and test results, feedback from teachers and your own expectations and goals of your learning.
