Counselling in Primary Care Service

This service is for short term counselling and is available locally through the GP service, while typically for those with medical cards only, it has now been extended to anyone who needs to be prioritised for a counselling service as a result of the critical incident. Referrals to this service are made via the GP.

Donegal Mental Health Services

Referrals to CAMHS and Adult Mental Health Services for people with significant mental health difficulties are made via the GP. **A priority assessment service is in place for those impacted.**

Donegal Bereavement Service and National Counselling Service

The Bereavement Service is available for adults over 18 years who present with traumatic or complex bereavements (typically noted six months post bereavement).

Adult Psychology Services
