Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

I hope you are well as we look forward to welcoming your child into 5th Year at Mulroy College for the coming school year. Please note our start dates for the beginning of the new academic term:

- Monday 28th August start date for 1st year students.
- Tuesday 29th August start date for 6th year students.
- Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> August start date for 5th year students.
- Thursday 31st August start date for 3rd year students.
- Friday 1st September start date for 2nd year students
- Monday 4th September start date for Transition year, LCA1 & LCA2 students.

As you are now aware, students will receive their books through the book rental **scheme (if payment has been commenced on-line)** together with a student journal that will have the calendar and dates for important events outlined. Lockers will also be provided within the first few days.

- There is a levy of €200.00 euro for the year which can be paid in instalments. This includes all
  payments for resources and equipment for practical subjects, books and workbooks for all
  subjects and exam papers for relevant subject areas.
- This can be paid through the Way2Pay System. You will receive a notification when this is set up for you in the coming weeks.
- We request that all monies are paid through this online system.
- Payment can be made in one lump sum or in instalments throughout the year.
- Following notification, you will receive a link to your mobile phone and you can proceed to pay at any time after you receive this link. Be aware of the amount you wish to pay as it will be set at €200. You can also log into www.mulroycollege.ie and click on the Way2Pay on the menu bar, where you will be asked to input your mobile number.
- Please note that your mobile number should be entered in international format. e.g. 087
- xxxxxxx should be entered as 35387xxxxxxxx.

All monies, levied by the school, whether by way of charges or contributions, will be used primarily for the benefit of the students for the purposes outlined. Any remaining funds will be used to further improve the teaching and learning experience for the students.

- ☐ If a student is **leaving the school early** the parent/guardian **must have a signed note in the diary explaining the reason for this**. This note has to be signed by the class teacher during morning registration.
- Students are not allowed to leave the premises with anyone other than a parent unless a prior arrangement has been made with the college.
- In the event of a student becoming ill/ or having to leave school urgently, the student must present themselves at the office and call home from the school as mobile phones are not permitted.
- ☐ If you need to collect your child at very short notice, please ring the school and arrangements can be made.

In the morning, due to the large volume of traffic parents are asked not to enter the college grounds when dropping their children off. Students are asked to be dropped off at the school gate to ensure the safety of all students. Likewise, in the evening parents are only permitted to park in the basketball court to ease congestion and for safety. The road leading to the back of the college must be kept clear at all times for emergency access. Your co-operation is very much appreciated on these matters.
