The SCP helps your child to:

- ✓ Attend school
- ✓ Focus on completing school
- ✓ Get involved in class and school activities
- ✓ Get the most from their education



## WHERE IS THE SCP AVAILABLE?

The SCP provides support to children and young people in the following schools:

## WHEN CAN SCP PROVIDE SUPPORT?

The SCP supports children and young people:

- ✓ During the school day
- ✓ During school holidays
- ✓ After school hours
- ✓ When out of school

## WHAT DO I NEED TO FILL OUT?

- 1 A referral form to see if SCP is the right support.
- 2 A consent to take part form (if the SCP is the right support).

Please ask the Home School Community Liaison Coordinator (HSCL) or a SCP staff person to help you with the forms.

## WHAT CAN SCP PROVIDE?
